

Ad Hoc Cemetery Committee
Minutes, April 15, 2013

The minutes were adopted as read

According to Becky Applin, single lots are being sold in the new section of Greenlawn, and there are some spaces available in the old section . There have been burials at Woodlawn. Becky will help the committee as a resource; contact to be made by the chair only. Becky was concerned that the rules do not specify who makes decisions about who can be buried in lots when the original owner has died.

A motion to adopt the rules as written was defeated. Items discussed were the fees and it was decided that the fees for urn burials (\$200 in all cemeteries but Greenlawn and \$100 in Greenlawn) should stay as they are. No change was made in the Construction section. The wording "double or larger lots" was approved as is.

Section 9 Violations was changed by a unanimous vote to read, "A. Decorations: If a decoration is placed on a lot in violation of these Regulations, Wiscasset's Highway Crew may remove the decoration and dispose of it without prior notice to the lot owner. "

Does the Road Commissioner have authority over family cemeteries? It appears that the road crew takes care of some, not of others.

A draft of the regulations with suggested changes will be distributed before the next meeting.
