

Ad Hoc Cemetery Committee  
Minutes, July 1, 2013

1. Call to Order

Chairman Don Jones called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m. Members present were Cindy Collamore, Don Jones, Jackie Lowell and David Sutter.

2. New Member

The chairman welcomed Cindy Collamore as a new member of the committee.

3. Approval of Minutes

David Sutter moved to approve the minutes as presented. Vote 3-0-1.

4. Enforcement Procedures

The Enforcement Procedures as outlined by Don Jones were approved.

5. Discussion of Revised Regulations

The committee discussed Jackie's reorganization of the regulations that eliminated duplication of sections, added a definitions section and simplified the wording of charges. The committee made corrections, additions and deletions to the draft which will be retyped and sent to committee members for approval at the next meeting.

6. Miscellaneous Questions

Cindy asked why the regulations prohibited a monument on a single grave or on the graves in the memorial garden. Cost of maintenance was one suggestion, particularly in the memorial garden. This may be discussed with the selectmen.

David Sutter asked about perpetual care for graves in small family cemeteries and whether all graves are receiving perpetual care at this point. He also questioned whether the new zero turn mower was being used on properties other than the town's cemeteries and how the purchase was funded.

The displaying of the American flag on graves in the Greenlawn Memorial Garden was discussed and will be brought up with the selectmen. Don will discuss this with Becky and the American Legion.

7. Next Agenda

The revised regulations will be distributed to members and will be voted on at the next meeting. The wording for the entrance signs will be discussed.
