

**Wiscasset Waterfront Committee Minutes**  
**Monday, October 22, 2001**  
**As corrected**

**Present:** Chairman Don Jones, Joe Piccirillo, and Dave Brown.

**Absent:** Secretary Phil DiVece, Greg Hammond (new member), and Harbormaster Bill Sutter.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10pm in the firehouse. A quorum was present. The minutes of the September 24 meeting were adopted without change. There was no report from the Harbormaster.

Joe and Don brought Dave up to date on the discussion held with Road Commissioner Woody Freeman on October 8, when there was not a quorum present. Don reported that based on the discussion with Freeman he had proposed to the selectmen putting the hauling and servicing of the floats out to bid. The selectmen decided not to do it this year, but would consider it for next year.

The committee reviewed the discussion at the September 27 public meeting on the future of the waterfront.

Next the committee began consideration of revised policy recommendations to the selectmen on the use of the Creamery Pier. Operating in workshop format the committee massaged some preliminary notes prepared by the chairman into a draft proposal, which will be considered for adoption at the next meeting.

The last three items on the agenda had been requested by Bill Sutter and Phil DiVece, who were not present, so discussion of them was postponed to a future meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45pm. **The next meeting will be on Monday, November 5 at 7pm in the firehouse.**
