

Wiscasset Waterfront Committee Minutes  
Monday, Feb. 18, 2002

Present: All committee members present: Chairman Don Jones; Phil Di Vece, secretary; David Brown, Greg Hammond, Joe Piccirillo and Harbormaster Bill Sutter.

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 p.m. in the firehouse. Minutes of the previous meeting held on Feb. 4 were reviewed and accepted as written. There was no agenda for the meeting, however several items of old business were discussed, in addition to some new business.

The waterfront committee went on record, 5-0, in opposition to a recommendation by the budget committee to disappropriate \$40,000 authorized by the town to purchase waterfront property abutting the Creamery Pier from the Haggett Family. The committee recommends selectmen proceed to purchase the property as intended by the voters of the town.

Gregg Hammond provided a brief update on Maine Yankee's new waterfront security zone. The restricted zone went into effect Dec. 10, 2001 and will remain in effect until June 15, 2002.

Joe Piccirillo recommended the committee go on a field trip to see the Dragon Cement facility on the Rockland waterfront. Harbormaster Bill Sutter said the best time to view this would be during loading or unloading of the cement products. The chairman will look into making arrangements for the visit.

The meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m. The next regular meeting of the committee was set for Monday, March 4 at 7 p.m. in the firehouse.
