

**Wiscasset Waterfront Committee Minutes  
Monday July 1, 2002**

**Present:** Chairman Don Jones, Greg Hammond, Joe Piccirillo, Tony Colby, and Harbormaster Bill Sutter.

**Absent:** Stuart Wyman

**Guests:** Frank Sprague

The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm in the firehouse. There was a quorum. The minutes of June 17 were approved without change. New member Tony Colby was welcomed. New member Stuart Wyman was absent.

The Harbormaster reported that he expects to have the final certified design for the new Main Pier fisherman's hoist by July 3, and hopes the installation will be complete within a few weeks. Commercial fishing permit applications will not be sent until after the hoist has been installed. Worm car renewals should be completed by July 31.

Frank Sprague explained his application for a Creamery Pier Vendor permit. He wishes to expand his takeout lunch business to include a second building in which he will steam lobsters for shore dinners. His new building would be 8 feet by 12 feet, and he proposes to locate it adjacent to his lunch wagon trailer. He proposed to put out the same six picnic tables that he used last summer, and whose use is not restricted to his own customers. He requested electrical service, and permission to tow his trailer onto the pier.

The following motion was made by Don Jones and seconded by Greg Hammond: **The committee cannot approve the application as presented because Creamery Pier policies allow only one building per business, and because the longest dimension of his lunch wagon exceeds the allowable 20 feet. Should the selectmen nevertheless decide to grant a permit, the committee recommends granting permission to use a vehicle to tow the trailer onto the reinforced area of the pier, but the trailer must be moved by hand to location A. The committee further recommends permission for six picnic tables open to the public be granted.** The motion was passed 4,0,0.

Robert Stanley was not present to explain his Creamery Pier vendor application for Tideway Treks kayak tours. Since committee members had questions unanswered on the application the form, **the committee tabled action on the application until the applicant can be present.** The motion to table was made by Joe Piccirillo, seconded by Tony Colby, and approved 4,0,0.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40pm. **The next meeting will be in the firehouse on Monday July 15 at 7pm.**
