

**Wiscasset Waterfront Committee Minutes**  
**Monday July 15, 2002**

**Present:** Chairman Don Jones, Greg Hammond, Joe Piccirillo, Tony Colby, and Stuart Wyman.

**Absent:** Harbormaster Bill Sutter

**Guests:** None

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm in the firehouse. There was a quorum. The minutes of July 1 were approved with one change. The following sentence was added to the third paragraph. Mr. Sprague was told that he must comply with state law with respect to the installation of a propane gas tank.

There was no report from the harbormaster. A memo was distributed from the town manager regarding the advisability of posting a sign at the waterfront park stating that dogs must be leashed or under voice control. No action was taken on the memo.

Mr. Stanley was not present, so no action was taken on his creamery pier application for a second time.

The committee reviewed a memo from MMA regarding proposed state legislation on siting aquaculture facilities. The committee felt Wiscasset should reply to MMA that it preferred the state-local partnership option, but decided to discuss it with the harbormaster before forwarding a recommendation to the town manager.

Under other business the location of the town-rented portable toilet was brought up. The members felt that the present location was poor. Joe motioned and Greg seconded that the committee recommend to the selectmen that the portable toilet be located near the southwest corner of the Creamery Pier. The motion passed 4-1-0 with Don opposing. Don felt the best place for it would be under the tree at the water's edge near the northeast corner close to the bridge.

Joe said that he had observed kayaks being rented on the Pedestrian Pier by someone without a permit. Don suggested that Joe and the other members try to get more information so that the committee can discuss the matter further at the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:35pm. **The next meeting will be in the firehouse on Monday August 5 at 7pm.**
