

The Wiscasset Historic Preservation Committee met April 18, 2019 at 4:56 P.M. The meeting was called to order by Chairman John Reinhardt who asked the other members, Leslie Roberts and Pam Logan to introduce themselves. It was noted that Gordon Konrath has resigned.

A motion was made by Leslie Roberts to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion seconded and approved.

Old Business

Mr. Colburn, father of Ed Colburn, presented additional details concerning the COA at 15 Water St. A new sign over the front will replace the old, naming the restaurant Water Street Kitchen and Bar. The sign at the back of the restaurant will be repainted with no changes. The rear egress will be constructed of cedar. HVAC units, 5 in all, will be covered by louvered frames. It was moved by Leslie Roberts and seconded by Pam Logan to approve the Water St. amendments. Motion approved 3 – 0.

Susan Blagden began discussion concerning the procedure of a COA. Members made the decision that the COA must be submitted by the first Tuesday of the preceding month. The Committee will return the applicant by the third Tuesday.

Members agreed that new commissioners are needed and that election of officers should take place in May.

There was no new business.

Leslie Roberts moved to adjourn. Motion seconded and approved. Meeting adjourned at 6:20.
