## Broadband Warrant on June 13th Ballot

**ARTICLE #47:** Shall the Town vote to appropriate an amount not to exceed \$183,200 from the Capital Reserve Account as a Grant Match for State funding for the purpose of providing a Fiber-Optic Broadband Network throughout the Town?

**Informational note**: These funds are expected to secure almost \$4 million in additional state, county and private funding towards the project. The funds will only be expended if the additional funds are received.
