

The Wiscasset Historic Preservation Committee met on March 21, 2019 at 5:00 P.M. Present were Chairman John Reinhardt, Gordon Konrath and Leslie Roberts.

The first order of business dealt with the COA of Mr. Dion West at 5 Evergreen Street in Wiscasset. His addendum was discussed. The Chairman thanked him for his second visit to the commission. Gordon Konrath moved to approve Mr. West's request with no changes, seconded by Leslie Roberts. Motion approved 3 – 0.

Old Business

Leslie Roberts asked if the Commission was ready for the COA on Water Street. John Reinhardt had talked to the architect about the April meeting, noting that the COA must be complete or cannot be posted by the town.

This COA needs more information and must be finished by Tuesday, March 26, in order to post. The chairman will e-mail both owner and his architect to ask for more information about the fire escape with drawings, the condensing unit and signage.

Leslie Roberts spoke of the Bicentennial Conference in Portland on March 15 and how it will decide to organize, including how much money is needed.
