It was pointed out that there have been numerous Newspaper articles, You Tube appearances, and a letter was sent to all property owners within the District. She remains unhappy.

Leslie and Pam will work on a postcard to be mailed to all property owners in the District. They will also see about expanded inclusion on the Town website and more internet coverage.

There is a place on the disclosure form for that information. Gordon suggested a sign be erected at the entrance of all streets coming into the District notifying people that they are entering an Historic District.
