Meeting Minutes  
March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014

Meeting called to order at 1801

Approved the minutes from Jan. and Feb. meetings.

No public comment offered.

Dan Bradford gave us copies of his harbormaster annual report. We will meet on Thurs. 03-20-14 to finalize our report as this needs to be submitted by 04-01-14.

We reviewed the pier vendor applications. We had three to consider. First was the Maine Craft Shack. They would like to change the position of their building to face the entrance more directly. We agree this may be done and they may ask the PWD to do so. Application approved by a vote of 5 in favor and none opposed

Second was Sprague's. This is also a returning vendor .Application approved by a vote of 4 in favor, none opposed. (Frank Sprague abstained)

Third was a new vendor. Two Bridges Industries would like to sell wood products made by prison inmates at Two Bridges jail. She had samples of decorated wooden boxes, a bird feeder that looked like Red's Eats and a folding chair with an ingenious design. The shop will be manned by officers, Application approved by a vote of 5 in favor, none opposed

It has come to our attention that the benches on the railing of the Main St pier are rotting and have a fungal growth weakening them more. At this point we need to remove any that are not safe to prevent accidental injuries this season. Repairs approved by vote of 5 in favor and none opposed. We will ask the DPW to follow up on this.

We are hoping to have 2 half whiskey barrels with flowers on each pier this summer. We will need to be able to water them. There is a faucet available for each pier. Margo will continue to seek donations of barrels and soil.

Susan introduced Travis Pryor from Wright-Pierce who will be presenting the information with Misty Parker at the public meeting regarding the boardwalk study this evening.
