follows: RECREATIONAL VEHICLE: A vehicle or attachment to a vehicle designed to be towed, and designed for temporary sleeping or living quarters for one or more persons, and which may include a pick-up camper, travel trailer, tent trailer, camp trailer, and motor home. In order to be considered as a vehicle and not as a structure, the unit must remain with its tires on the ground, and must be registered with the State Division of Motor Vehicles. A vehicle which is: a. built on a single chassis, b. 400 square feet or less when measured at the largest horizontal projection, not including slideouts; c. designed to be self-propelled or permanently towable by a motor vehicle; and d. designed primarily not for use as a permanent dwelling but as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, travel, or seasonal use.
