Peter Wells is ready to go to BOS with proposal for kayak racks at waterfront to be attached to Harbor Master building. He and Terri will donate one rack (\$760). The town will collect rental fees. Suggested fees would be \$40/year for residents and \$100/year for nonresidents. Spaces would be open to residents for 3 weeks then open to all.

Kay Soule gave his Harbor Master report. Ray and Nicole are working on updating Commercial prior use application. We recommend that all mooring applications include proof of insurance on each vessel which includes a towing endorsement. Ray and Nicole continue to work on clearing mooring field of ghost moorings.

Ray will look into getting two 220 outlets in Harbor Master building for use during events for food trucks. It will cost \$1200 for new panel for 2 outlets. Ray will check if there are spaces not being used in current panels first.

Ray was able to retrieve seaweed bags floating down river. Also received call from Coast Guard regarding an 18 foot skiff adrift down river.

DEP will collect waste from Providence once warm enough to pump.

Ray reports the lock is missing from Commercial lift.

We would like to congratulate Ray on his Harbor Master certification.

Dick Forrest updated us on Providence progress. Planning to step masts on 04-04-19.

Kathy Onorato will be sending out vendor applications. We will check current applications are sent.
